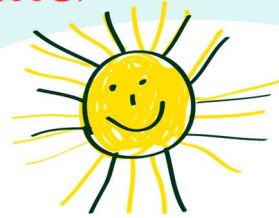


# St Andrew's C of E Infant School Newsletter

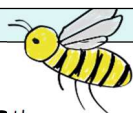


## BOB's Book of Brilliance
