Artist: Moira West Textiles: Our Landscape

## **Prior Learning:**

- Children will be familiar with using a variety of materials in Reception and will have had the opportunity to use these to create pictures in Reception Future Learning:
  - In Y2 children will produce a coastal landscape collage using different types of paper (not fabric)

Final Outcome: Natural landscape picture of Scotland using textiles inspired by Moira West (not coastal)

- Match and sort fabrics and threads for colour, texture, length, size and shape.
- Cut and shape fabric using scissors/snips.
- Apply shapes with glue or by stitching.
- Apply decoration using beads, buttons, feathers etc.
- Create cords and plaits for decoration.

## Colour

• Apply colour with printing, dipping or fabric crayons.

## **Drawing**

- Control the types of marks made with a range of media
- Identify light and dark marks and shapes.
