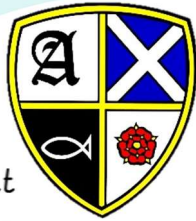

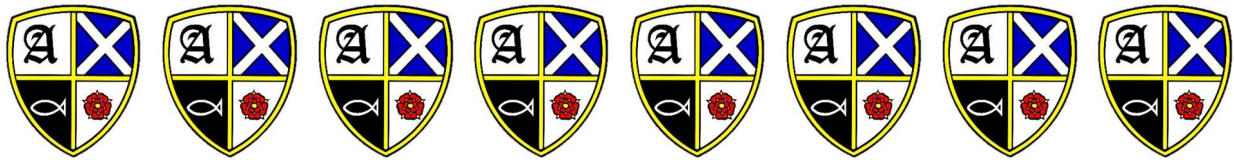
**This is not acceptable.** If this is you, you are putting lives at risk. From now on I will be recording number plates of reckless drivers and reporting them to the police.

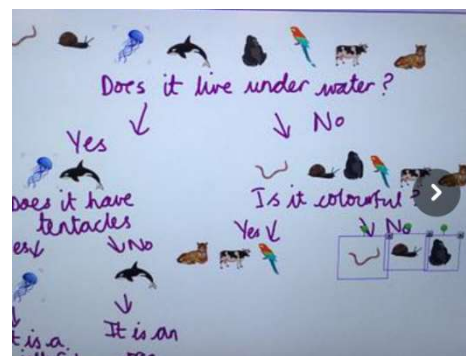
